Italy Tour

Overview:

The Italy tour is an opportunity for students to explore Italian language and culture. Students will participate in a one-week homestay experience in Ancona whilst staying with an authentic Italian family. Students will then visit the beautiful Italy exploring history, art, culture and religion. Students will visit Rome including a Papal Audience, Pompeii, Florence, Siena, Ancona and Venice. A truly spiritual and incredible experience for all students.

STEM with NASA Tour

Overview:

Students travel to Orlando USA to participate in a variety of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) related activities. Students visit Kennedy Space Centre participating in the *Astronaut Training Experience* and *Mars Base One Programs,* as well as visiting iFly to experience the physics of freefall, Universal Studios and

DisneyWorld, and complete ride analysis programs.

Hosting Opportunities

Hosting Students from Italy

During February, our College will be visited by 25 students from our Sister School in Ancona Italy. All students are encouraged to host a student from Italy for 1 week. Families are asked to provide accommodation and three meals a day for the duration of their stay. International Exchange students from Italy are approximately 14-15 years of age and speak English and Italian.

Hosting Students from Japan

Our College continues to work with the Australian Institute of International Understanding (AIIU) by offering our students the opportunity to host Japanese Exchange Students for an extended homestay. Our Japanese Exchange students will attend classes at our College for approximately 2 months whilst developing their English skills. Families are asked to provide accommodation and three meals a day for the duration of their stay. Payment is provided by AIIU.

Curriculum Links

Languages (Italian and Japanese)

Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs offers two Languages at Year 7. Students complete one Semester of Italian and one Semester of Japanese. In Year 8 students select one of these Languages to continue for the year. Students will develop skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking. They will learn about Italian and Japanese culture and in turn develop a better understanding of their own culture and language whilst improving their literacy and cognitive development. Students interested in Italian or Japanese language and culture are strongly encouraged to consider the Italy Tour or Japan Tour in Year 9 or 10. At Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs, we believe that immersing oneself in the culture of a country is the best way to learn a language.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)

The Year 10 STEM: Experiments in Space course enables students to learn coding techniques and develop critical thinking skills to solve problems that scientists have experienced with space exploration. Students are assessed on tasks relating to the planetary orbits, technological developments to aid human flight into space and the requirements for the establishment of a base on Mars. Students interested in studying STEM in Year 10 are encouraged to consider the STEM with NASA Tour.

Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs has made a five-year commitment to supporting the community of St Francis School, Kizinga in the district of Rakai, Southern Uganda.
