The College fulfils this through offering an engaging curriculum, faith formation encounters, celebration of the sacraments and liturgical life of the Church and strong relationships with our local parishes.






Student Wellbeing


Learning & Teaching

Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs is a member of SACCSS (Sports Association of Catholic Co-educational Secondary Schools), which hosts a number of major carnivals and events. Some of the sports included are golf, swimming, cross country, AFL, futsal, tennis, rugby and chess.

Students have the opportunity to participate in year level-based Premier League sports, including AFL, soccer, basketball, volleyball, netball and cricket.

Students have the opportunity to join the Mass ensemble or choir, acapella choir, concert band, along with a number of other choir and band options.

Production

Our College offers a musical production every year as a co-curricular activity. The production is audition-based with the pre-requisite that students are also members of a College choir or ensemble. Eventually we will also offer a Production band.

In recent years the College has presented Aladdin, Hairspray, Beauty and the Beast, The Wizard of Oz, Annie and Grease musicals.

STEM

Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) encourages students to develop critical and creative thinking skills, as well as teamwork to solve large-scale problems. Some activities include coding of Lego MindStorm and mBot Robots to complete a series of tasks, 3D printing and VEX Robotics Challenges, along with national and international excursion opportunities.

Art & Technology

Whether it is from the kitchen, on the green or art studios, we aim to foster talents and showcase them at their best. The College runs regular Arts Tech Exhibitions where students can present their masterpieces. We also run regular cooking related competitions and occasionally invite qualified chefs to come and demonstrate their expertise.

Clubs

At Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs, we offer a range of clubs including Chess Club, Languages Club, Book Club and Debating Club.

















Cultural Immersion Tours

STEM with NASA (Orlando, USA)

This is an incredible opportunity for our students to travel to Orlando USA to participate in a variety of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) related activities. Students visit Kennedy Space Centre participating in the Astronaut Training Experience and Mars Base One Programs. As well they will visit iFly to experience the physics of freefall, Universal Studios and Disney World, and complete ride analysis programs.

Japan

Students can experience Japanese culture and language through travelling, homestay and attending a school in Japan. They will visit Tokyo, Kyoto, Osaka and Hiroshima to experience both traditional and contemporary sides of Japanese culture.

Central Australia

Students experience the beauty of the outback and learn about ancient Aboriginal culture. Highlights of the trip include Uluru, Kata Tjuta, Tjoritja, King's Canyon and Watarrka National Park and the Earth Sanctuary. A visit to the Santa Teresa community is an especially significant and memorable experience.

Italy

Students can visit beautiful Italy exploring history, art, culture and religion. They will participate in a oneweek homestay experience in Ancona whilst staying with a local Italian family. Students visit Rome, which includes a Papal Audience, Pompeii, Florence, Siena, Ancona and Venice.

Kokoda

Students have an opportunity to travel to Papua New Guinea to trek the Kokoda Trail. An extreme experience that is equal parts physically and mentally challenging. Students will learn about the historical elements of the Kokoda Campaign and PNG culture.

Ignite Youth Conference

IYC enables young people to deepen their faith journey and experience in a dynamic way.

Australian Catholic Youth Festival

ACYF is a national gathering of Catholic young people. The purpose is to provide youth with opportunities to deepen their relationship with Jesus and encounter the vitality of the Church in Australia.

Uganda Project

Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs has established a relationship with the community of St Francis Primary School, Kizinga in the district of Rakai, in southern Uganda.

During our partnership and through the generosity of our students and their families, we have enabled the construction and furnishing of a brick classroom; developed a food program; sourced a clean water supply; refurbished the church with a concrete floor and rendered walls; and constructed two classroom buildings. Soon, water tanks will also be installed.

With the support of our community, we have given hope to hundreds of children and their families who otherwise would not have access to education.

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
