Catholic Regional College Caroline Springs uses a Learning Management System called SEQTA. We are now ready for new parents/carers to log in to the parent portal area of SEQTA, called 'SEQTA Engage'.

The link can also be found on the College website under the 'Portals' tab.

What tabs can parents/carers access via SEQTA Engage?

- Welcome – an introductory landing page.
- Assessments – your child's assessments for each subject.
- Courses – course outlines for the subjects your child is enrolled in.
- Dashboard – view your child's homework, timetable, pastoral care details and unresolved absences.
- Direct Messages – similar to an email account, this is one of the College's main communication tools. Access Inbox, Sent items, Starred and Trash folders here.
- Notices – view various announcements at specific year levels from College staff.
- Portals – access the parent, library and faith and mission portals.
- Reports – access your child's interim and semester reports.
- Settings – change your password and colour interface.
- Timetable – view your child's timetable.

To create your SEQTA login account for the first time, you will need to reset your password by selecting 'Forgot your password?'. [This video](#) demonstrates how to initiate a password reset. On Tuesday, you would have received an email from SEQTA, to initiate your password reset, along with your username.

You can download and install the SEQTA Engage Mobile App from the Apple and Google Play stores.
